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WILDCAT PRIDE


- ◆ Continually demonstrate Wildcat Pride

HISTORY

The Student Leadership Quality Standards (SLQS) were developed in 2016-17 by a special committee comprised of members from NDSCS student leadership organizations (Student Senate, Campus Activities Board, NDSCS Ambassadors, Wildcat Welcome Team and Residential Life) and were formally adopted in August 2017. These standards were developed to provide a consistent understanding by all student leaders of the expectations they must uphold as they lead their fellow students.
