- Documentation of the student qualifying for a state tuition or other state benefit accorded to the children or other family members of a public safety officer consistent with the definition in 42 U.S.C. 3796b, or as a fire police officer
- Other documentation from a credible source that describes or reports the circumstances of the death and occupation of the parent or guardian.
