### 4. Guest Speaker

 Melissa Johnson, Associate Vice President for Student Affairs- HLC Student Survey

Melissa Johnson explained that the Higher Learning Commission evaluates institutions every 10 years.

A survey will be open from February 3 to 12 to gather student feedback and experiences at NDSCS. Participation is anonymous and voluntary.

A site visit for accreditation is scheduled for April 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>, with a team of peer reviewers familiar with 2 year institutions will go visit our institution. Dr. Karch will send out reminders on February  $3^{rd}$  and  $7^{th}$ .

- Heather Weber, Director of Dining Services- Dining Plan Rates
- Wildcat Dining has extended meal hours from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. this semester. The deli, soup, and salad bar will be open from 2-4 p.m. before hot food is available.
- Grab and Go is now only available in the dining room on the left side of the entryway.
- Three new full-time and one part-time employee have been added to Wildcat Express. The addition of new staff has slowed the burger line wait to 11 minutes but every day the time has been shortening.
- Senator Hiltner and Heather Weber review comment cards weekly to accommodate student requests in dining, such as bringing back pickle spears on the salad bar.
- A satisfaction survey for dining hours and food will be conducted in April.
- A 4% increase in dining plans is proposed to cover employee pay and increased food costs, which is 5-6% higher than last year.
- Odyssey is a software on campus that involves using student IDs for various services. The dining department is looking to upgrade the software, because the software will not be functioning by 2027. Potential new software could allow for mobile phone integration, nutritional information, personal photos on ID cards, cameras, and new sound systems.

- Athletics is seeking a 25% increase to support staffing and cleanup.
- IT is requesting a 50% increase in the technology fee from \$30.53 to \$37.08 to maintain software, hardware, and staffing. This would also pay for an individual to plan onboarding and integration on the campus.
- The Clubs and Organization Fee is proposed increase to \$1.67 per credit, generating \$55,750 to cover all expenses for Competitive Clubs on campus. This Fee increase would cost students approximately \$78.60 more each semester. Fundraising and sponsorship are also being considered to offset costs.
